Hello neighbors,

We are proud to introduce the Block Studio Project!

Funded by Logan Park Neighborhood Association, our pilot project will build and place 10 Block Studios throughout Logan Park. The Block Studio is an arts and craft version of corner donation boxes. Each will offer a place for artists and crafters of all skill levels to exchange ideas, tools, and materials. But more than that, it is a place for neighbors to create with a spare 15 minutes (the door functions as drop down workspace), or even add to the Studio as a growing, organic art piece.

A monthly newsletter will show the location of all the Block Studios, as well as what arts or craft focus each Studio maintains. Our first one is on the corner of 15th and Jefferson and is primarily a drawing and coloring Studio.

We also hope to begin a series of 20 minute Walk Up Workshops, rotating through the Studios, where the host or a volunteer provides instruction on a technique or project.



If you are interested, there are three easy ways to participate:

- Become a Studio host. If you are a homeowner, commercial property owner, or renter with landlord's permission in the Logan Park area, and you'd like to host a Studio on your property, let us know. The Studio is free, and we will even help install it without cement! No skills are needed. Even if you've only had a passing interest in learning an art or craft, this is a great way to start.
- You'll be responsible for maintaining the Studio and making sure it remains stocked we will help with start-up materials and connecting you with donors. You can take it any direction you want, as long as the tools and materials are kid safe.
- Become a Studio visitor. Just walk up and participate. Feel free to add or take appropriate materials and resources, create something, or add to the outside decoration of the Studio. Keep an eye out for the Walk Up Workshops as well when they begin in May/June.
- Become a Studio supporter. We are looking for artists, crafters, and hobbyists to donate old tools, materials, books, and resources. We are also looking for individuals who may not want to host, but are willing to support a Studio with shared areas of interest. This would mean providing contact information for the host, and be willing to visit the Studio regularly to check for needed materials or even volunteer to run a Walk Up Workshop at the Studio.
