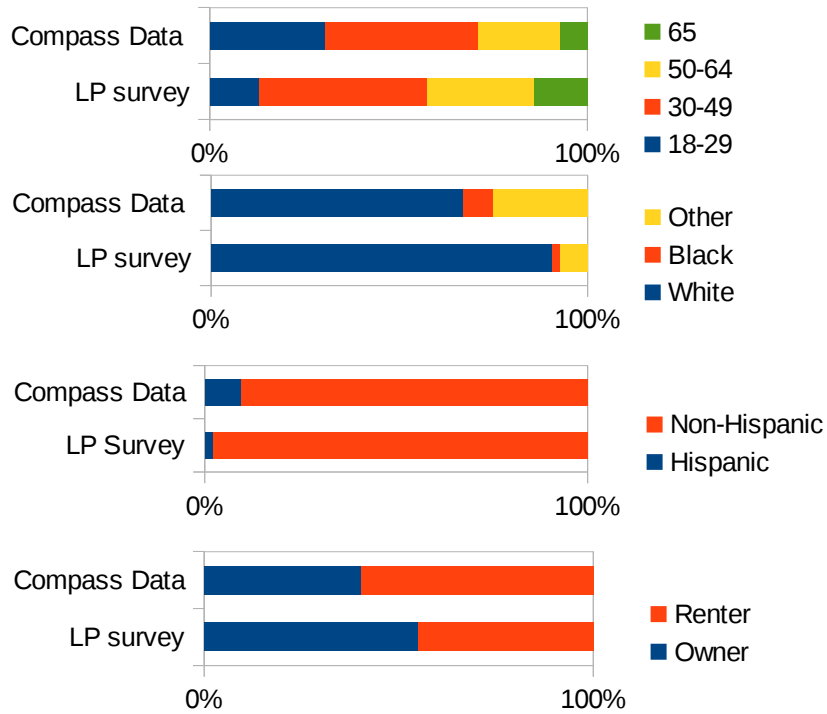


# Logan Park Neighborhood Priorities Survey – Summary

- Total of 118 responses, 11.3% of households

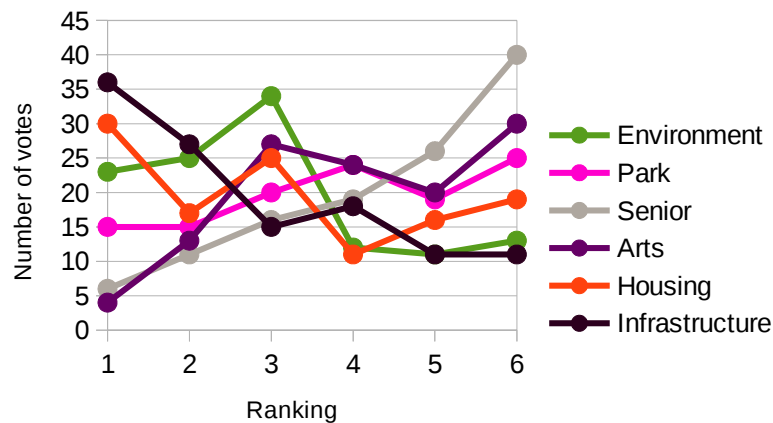
## Demographics:

“Compass Data” is statistics for Logan Park from the city for home ownership status and age; city-wide for race.



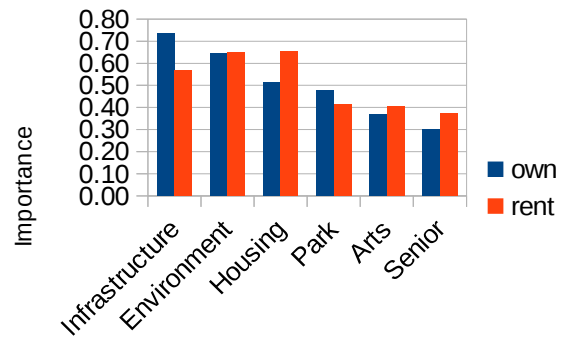
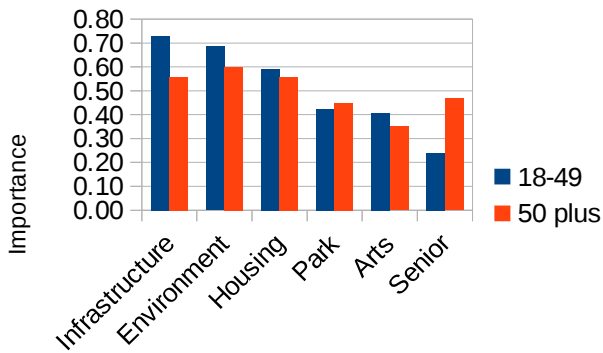
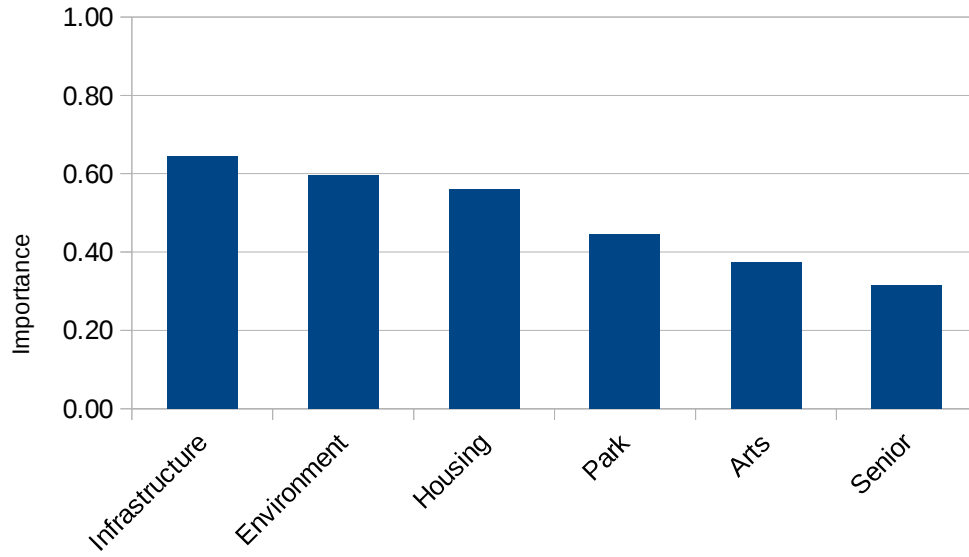
## Rankings:

Respondents were asked to rank priorities of Infrastructure, Environment, Housing, Park-related issues, Arts and Culture, and Senior issues from 1 to 6.



**Priorities:**

“Importance” is calculated by assigning five points to a first-place vote and zero to a sixth-place vote. It is scaled so that a priority that is ranked #1 by every respondent will score 1. A higher score means a more importance to respondents.



## Ideas:

*Respondents were asked to provide their own ideas for ways to use LPNA's funds. A complete list can be found in the "complete results" document. Here are some common responses, and a rough count of the number of interested respondents:*

### **Environment**

- More lighting, especially solar-powered lighting (11)
- Plants, trees, bees and gardens (7)
- Some mechanism of funding for residential solar (5)

### **Parks**

- Workout equipment in the park (6)
- Various ideas for music, movies, and theater programming (6)
- Want more activities for kids and teens (4)
- Garden in the park (3)
- Dog park (3)

### **Senior Issues**

- Aging-in-place related ideas and programs (3)

### **Arts and Culture**

- Art combined with infrastructure – painting street, utility boxes, under railroad bridges (5)

### **Housing**

- Various request for affordable-housing initiatives (7)
- Loan programs for owners to improve property (6)

### **Infrastructure**

- Concerns regarding the safety of Broadway Ave. (5)
- Calls for bike and pedestrian-related infrastructure (14)
- Requests for resident permit parking (4)
- Request for more funding for snow removal on sidewalks (4)
- Concerns about traffic issues (4)

### **Other**

- Crime, safety, and police-related (5)
