Animal control - rescues, rehab, reunite families with

Fire Inspection – Inspect units of four or more units and commercial locations

Housing inspection – Inspection of 1 to 3 unit buildings, provide support

Traffic control – for events, special rush hour operations, removal of abandoned vehicles

Review of enforcement data for traffic

Housing and Fire – 420 citations in our area, reviewed rental licenses
