Pavillion Updates

Larry and Pat V reported there is a challenge in the way the contract gets set up. Previously NCR transferred the funds directly to the MPRB, however now we will pay the vendors and donate the structure to the park. Bob Cooper at NCR will redo the contract. Pat V will reach out to Clark to see if he would be the official project manager. We will also reach out to Chris Meyer, Park Board Commissioner and the local churches.

Mural Updates - Michelle met with R2 about potential mural spaces. They support the idea but couldn't identify any spaces on Quincy Hall. Michelle will reach out to Hillcrest and also explore the Central Ave bridge as a space.

Census Event - Steve is coordinating a project with Sheridan and Edison. Edison is creating videos that promote the Censu in several different languages, neighborhood organizations will help distribute and promote.

Strategic Planning Updates Several board members had a brainstorming session with our strategic planning consultants. Some things that came up : create a welcome packet, promote artists in the newsletter, have different styles of meetings or non meetings.
